Are you a breast cancer survivor suffering from a permanent reduction in nipple sensitivity and associated decrease in sexual quality of life?

If you are a female between 18 and 70 years of age, first diagnosed with stage I or II breast cancer, have had breast surgery (nipple sparing mastectomy or lumpectomy) resulting in nipple neuropathy reduced nipple sensitivity and you are at least 3 years post breast surgery, you are invited to join a clinical research study examining the effectiveness of a topical drug that could restore nipple sensitivity and improve your sexual quality of life*.

You must be willing to engage in sexual activity at least once a month during the duration of the study and able to comply for 8 consecutive weeks.

Volunteers will receive study related physicians visits at no cost as well as payment of \$50 per visit for time and effort and \$25 travel reimbursement.
